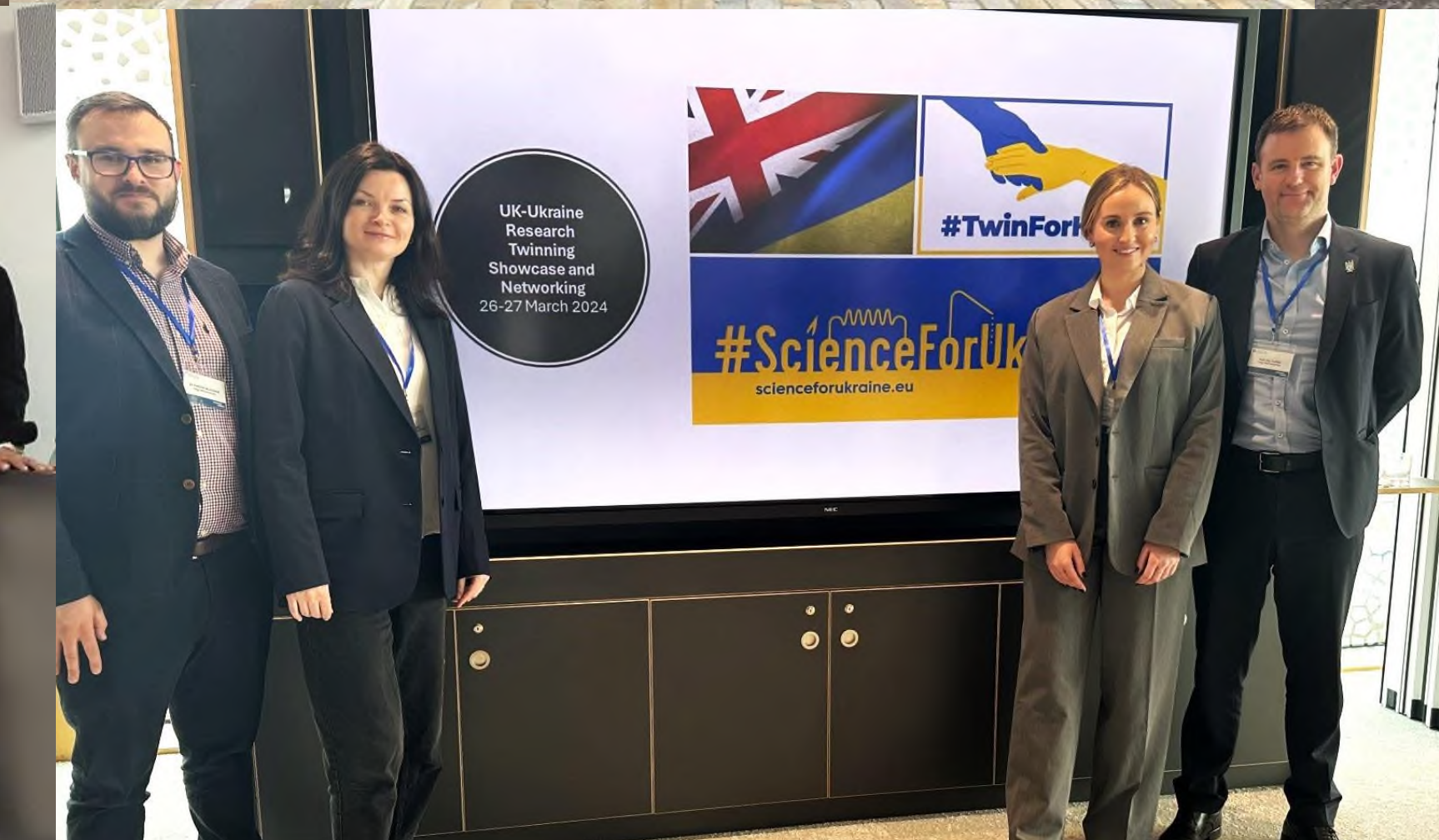
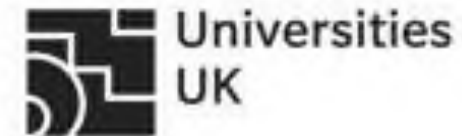

# Compulsory Modules

- NLU students have one compulsory module:
- Law 4016\_ONL – Dissertation
  - 10,000 word piece of independent legal research
  - Completed during semester three, due in August 2023
  - Supervised by Edge Hill and NLU staff
  - Worth one third of the overall degree
  - EHU Library provides support to NLU students for research techniques, legal writing and referencing (OSCOLA).



# Optional Modules

- Each module is worth c. 8% of the overall degree.
- Students choose four modules, run in semester two.
- Delivered online, new lecture content every two weeks
- Asynchronous seminar activities with other NLU students
- Law4024\_ONL – Regulating Intellectual Property Law in Cyber Space
- Law4024\_ONL – Digital and Cyber Financial Crime
- Law4025\_ONL – Cyber Crime: Detection, Investigation and Enforcement
- Law4027\_ONL – Digital Platforms and Competition Law
- Law4028\_ONL – Blockchain, Crypto and Digital Technology Law



# Assessments

There are three forms of assessments employed by the School of Law and Criminal Justice for online students:

- Time Limited Assessments
  - Generally 24 hours.
  - Students given an exam and have 24 hours to complete it and upload the script to the VLE
- Presentations via online platform
  - Asynchronous – students prepare presentations and upload them by the deadline to the VLE
- Coursework
  - Essay Question
  - Can be 1,500, 2000 or 3,000 words
  - Title given to students in advance
